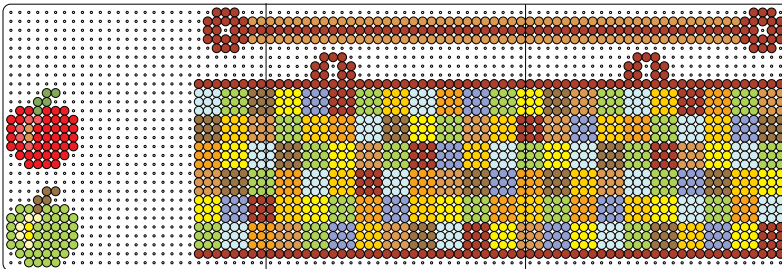




Instructions

To complete your project, you will need **THREE** large square pegboards, the beads, a can about 4" diameter and 3.25" deep (a mixed nuts can works well), 2-3 heavy rubber bands, 2 small paper fasteners or brads, raffia ribbon, wooden skewers, thick craft glue, plus your flower arranging materials.

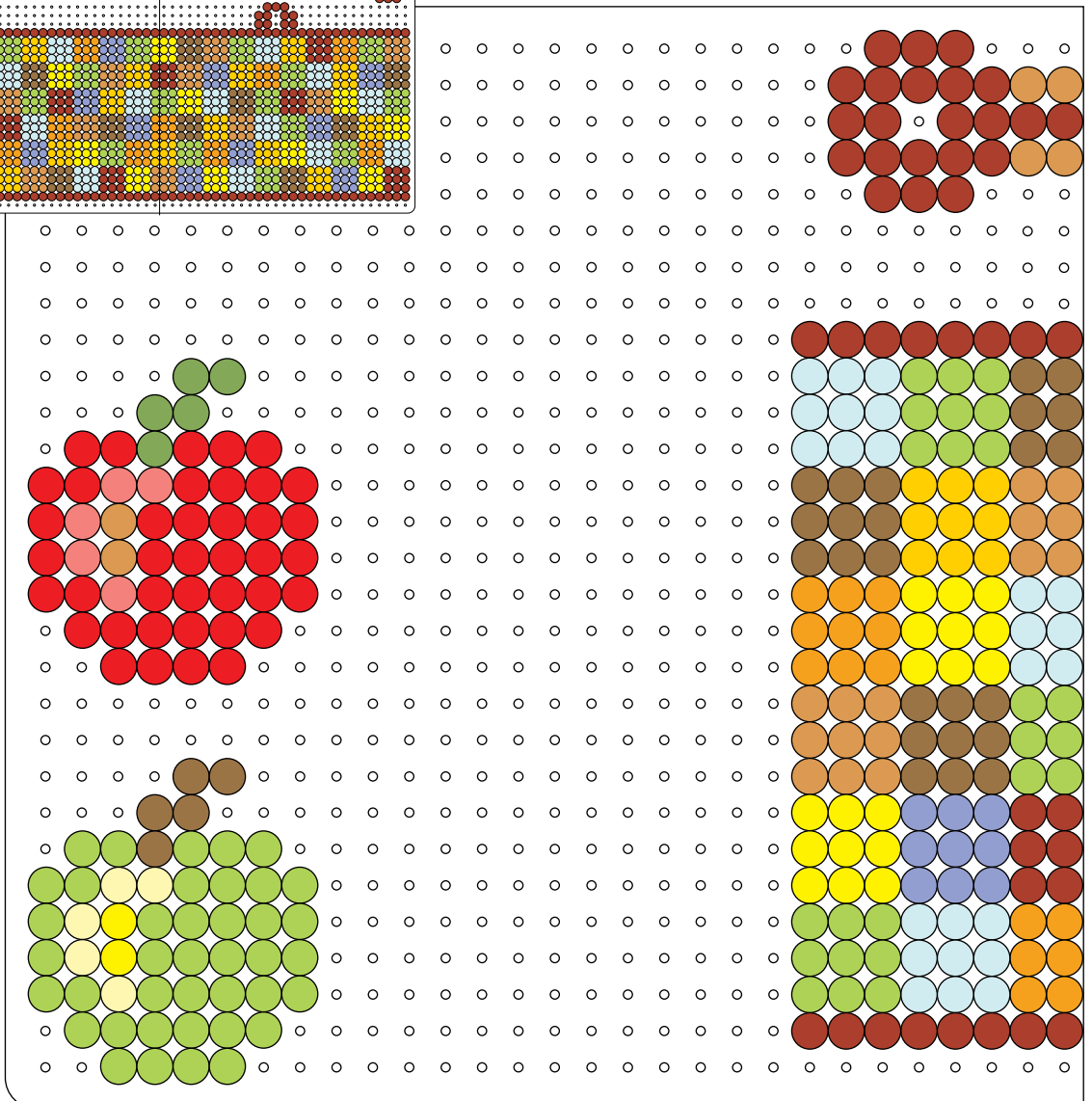
1. Assemble the three large square pegboards as shown below left. Cut out the individual sections of the chart and tape them together so that you can see the whole design at once. If you're using clear pegboards, slide the actual-size pattern underneath them. Now place all the beads for your project.
2. Cover the completed design with the ironing paper. Keeping the iron level, gently iron the beads in a circular motion for about 10 seconds to fuse the beads evenly. Ironed properly, the beads will still have an open center.
3. Once the design is cool, peel off the ironing paper. Lift your designs from the pegboard and set aside the basket pieces (the large rectangle and handle). These pieces will not be ironed on the other side because they need to remain flexible. Take the apple pieces and flip them over and repeat step #2. Your pegboard and ironing paper are reusable. 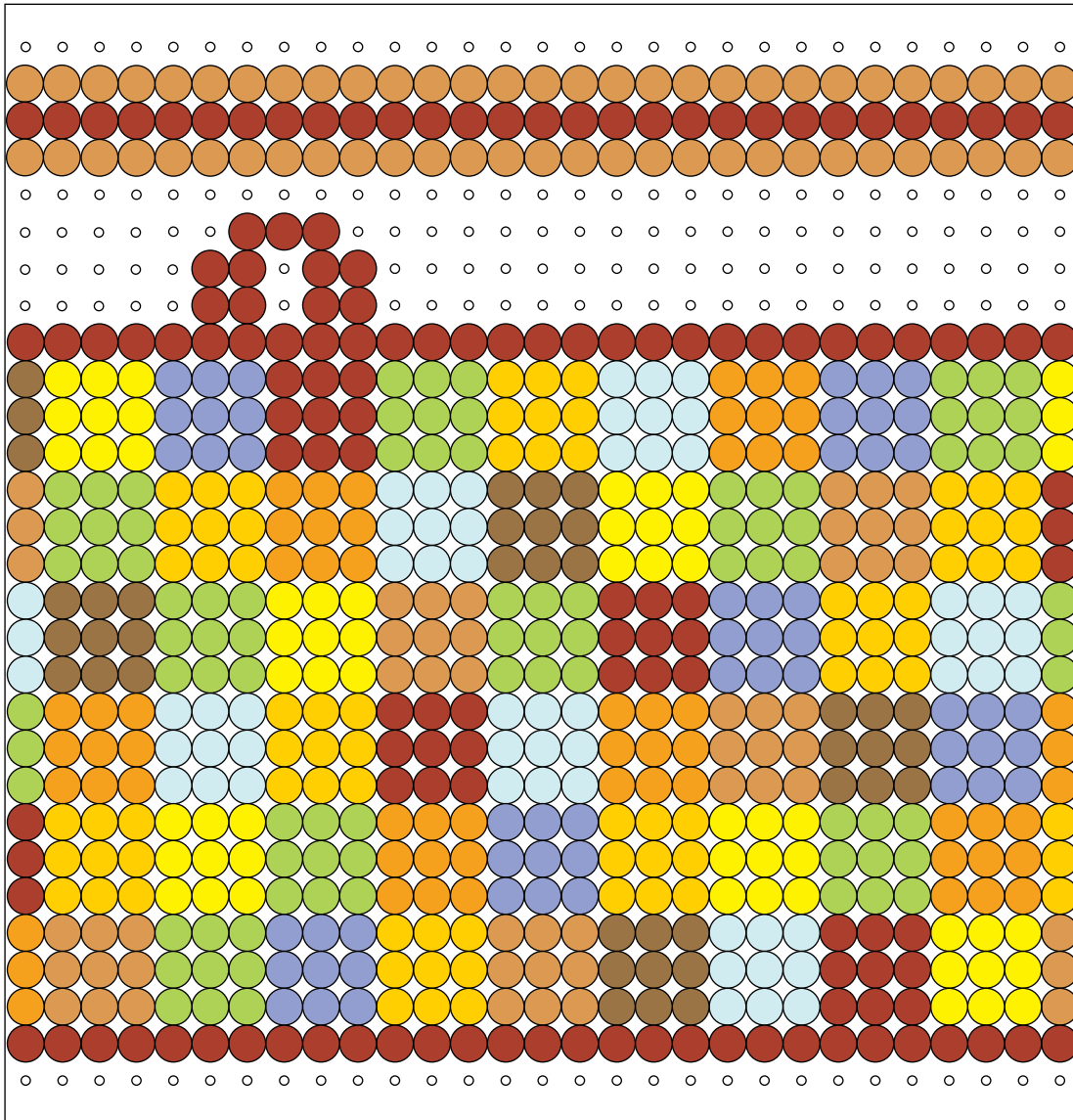
Assembly of Pegboards

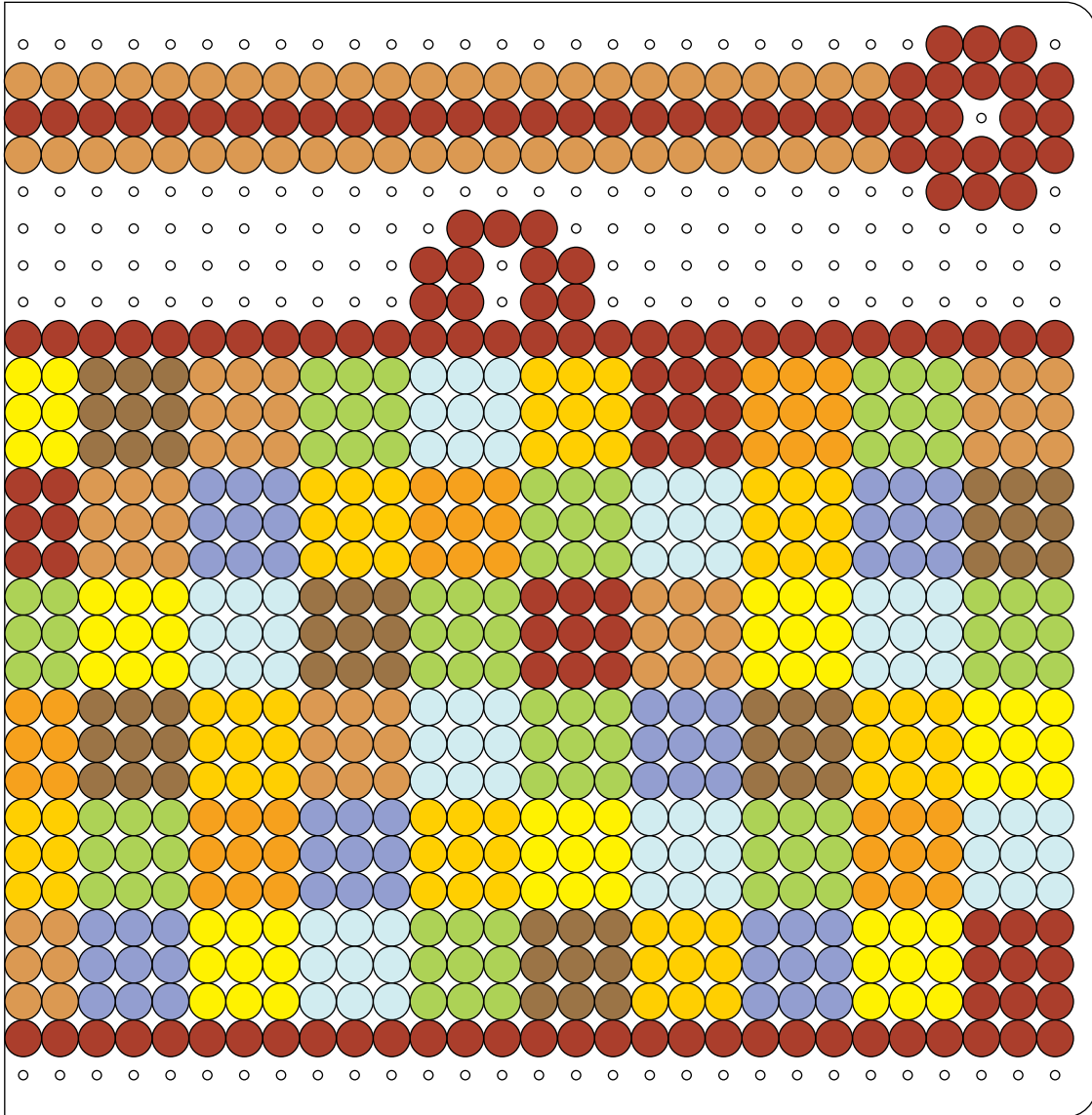

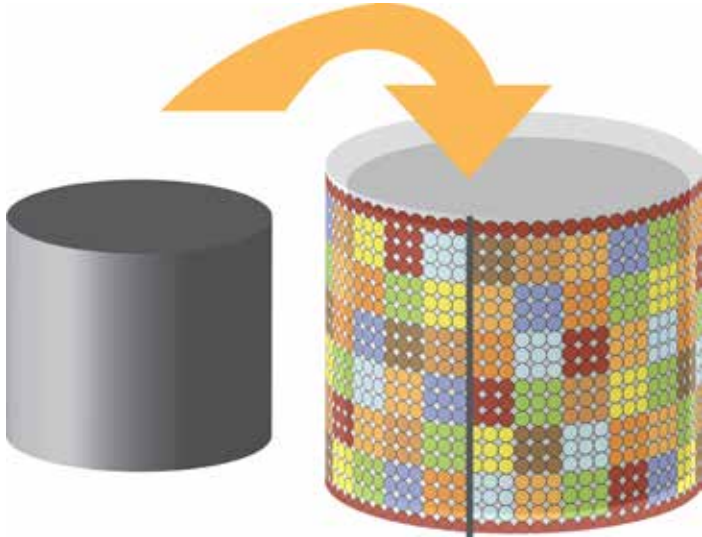

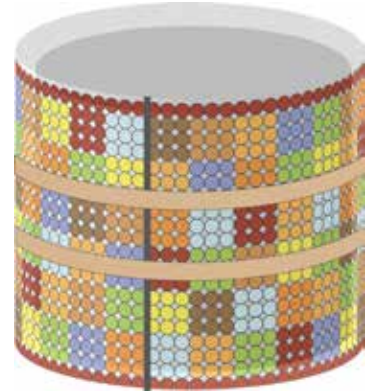

ASSEMBLY

1 Wrap the large basket piece around the can, making sure to place the ironed side facing the can.



2 Glue this piece to the can with craft glue and hold in place with a few rubber bands until it dries.



3 Use two paper fasteners to connect the handle to the basket.



4 Arrange your fresh or silk flowers in the basket. Tie a small raffia bow to each of the apple pieces, then glue a skewer to each apple. Insert in your arrangement.
