



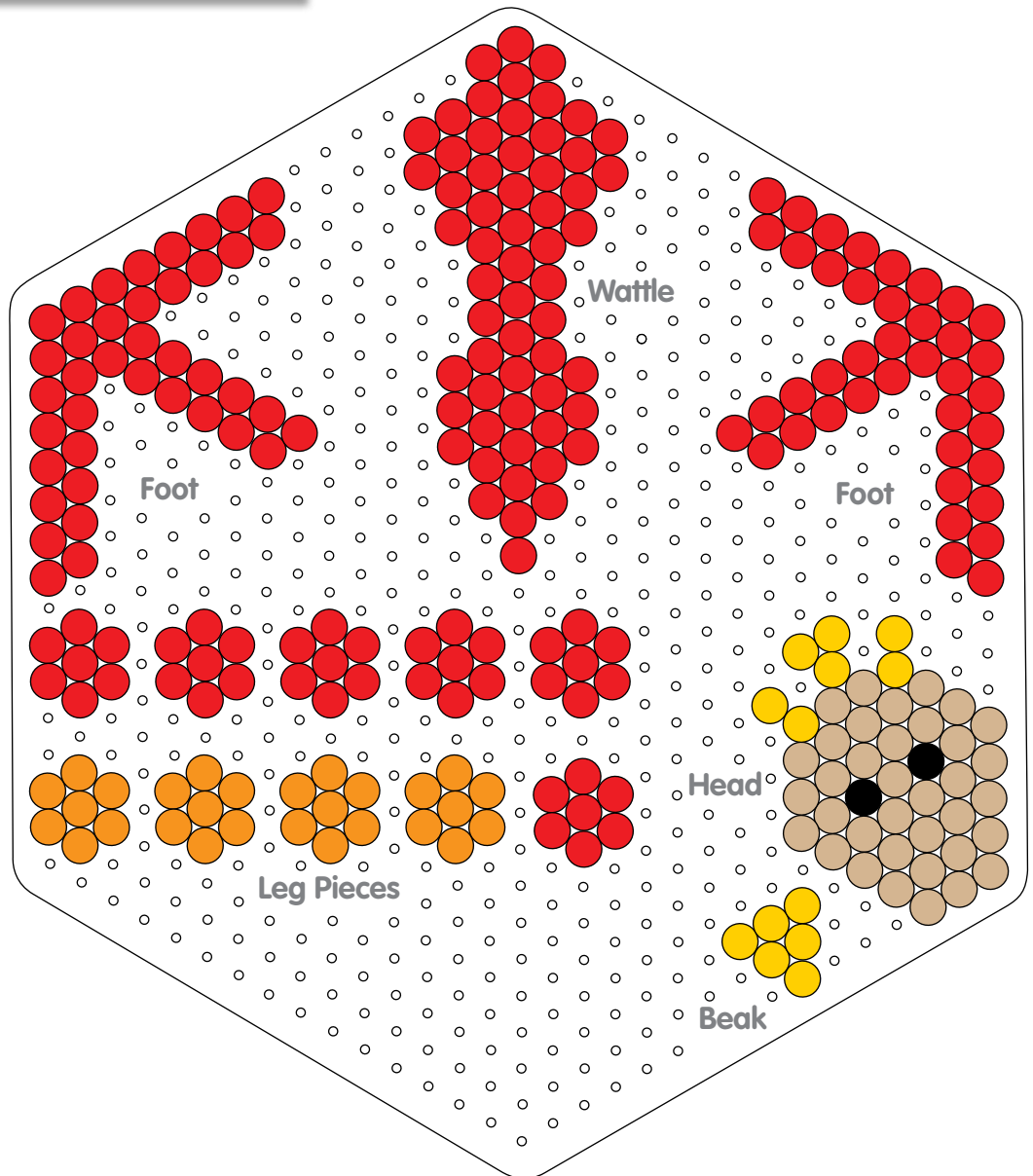
Instructions

1. Use the large hexagon pegboard for your project. If you're using a clear pegboard, slide the actual-size pattern underneath it. Place all the beads for the design.
2. Cover the completed design with the ironing paper. Keeping the iron level, gently iron the beads in a circular motion for about 10 seconds to fuse the beads evenly. Ironed properly, the beads will still have an open center.
3. Once the design is cool, peel off the ironing paper. Lift your design from the pegboard; flip the design over and repeat step #2. Your pegboard and ironing paper are reusable.

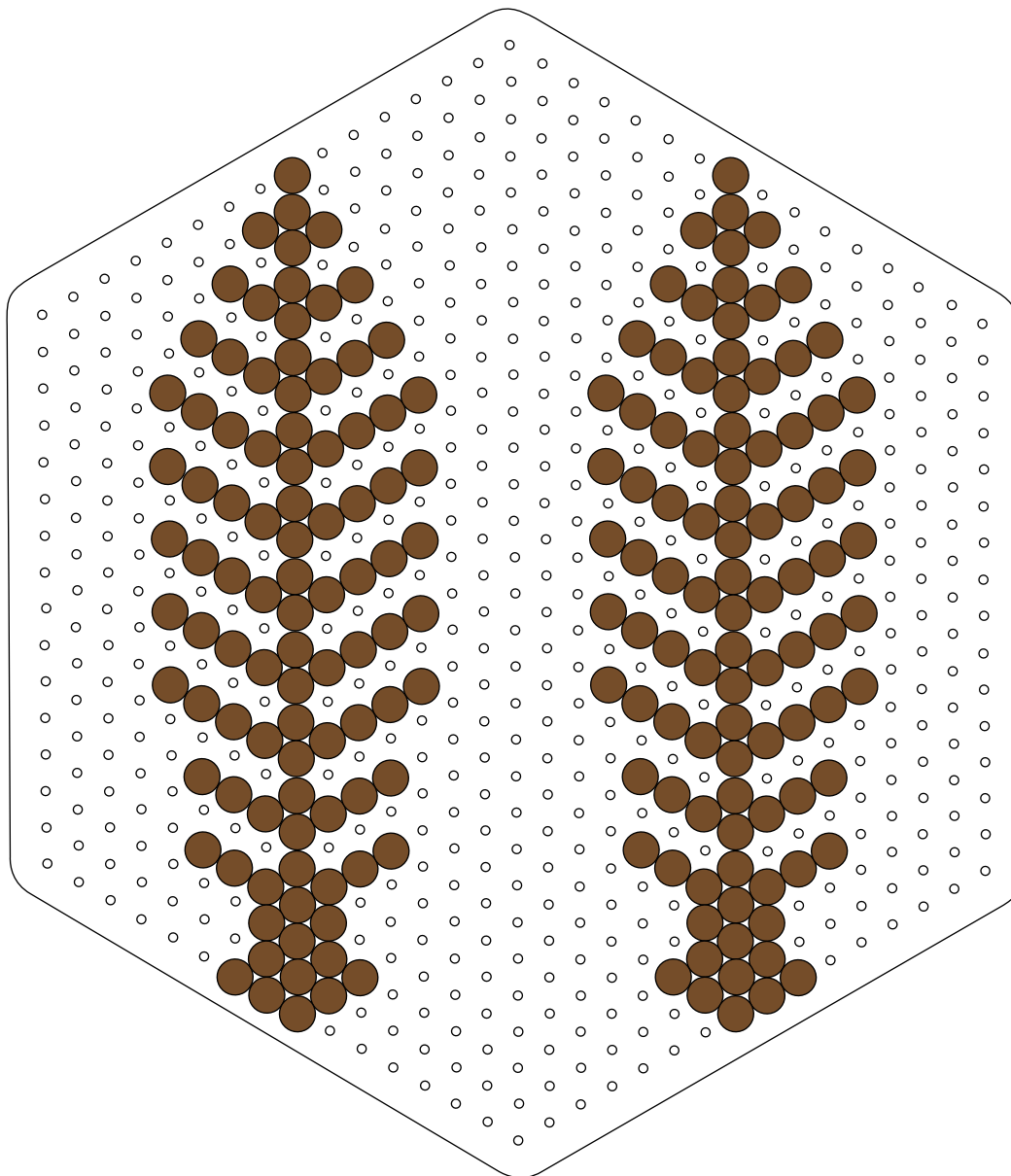
You will also need a small pumpkin and some craft glue to complete your project. If you prefer, you can use bamboo skewers instead where the instructions say to glue pieces to the pumpkin.

Bead Color/# Needed:

- Red - 181
- Orange - 28
- Cheddar - 13
- Tan - 36
- Black - 2



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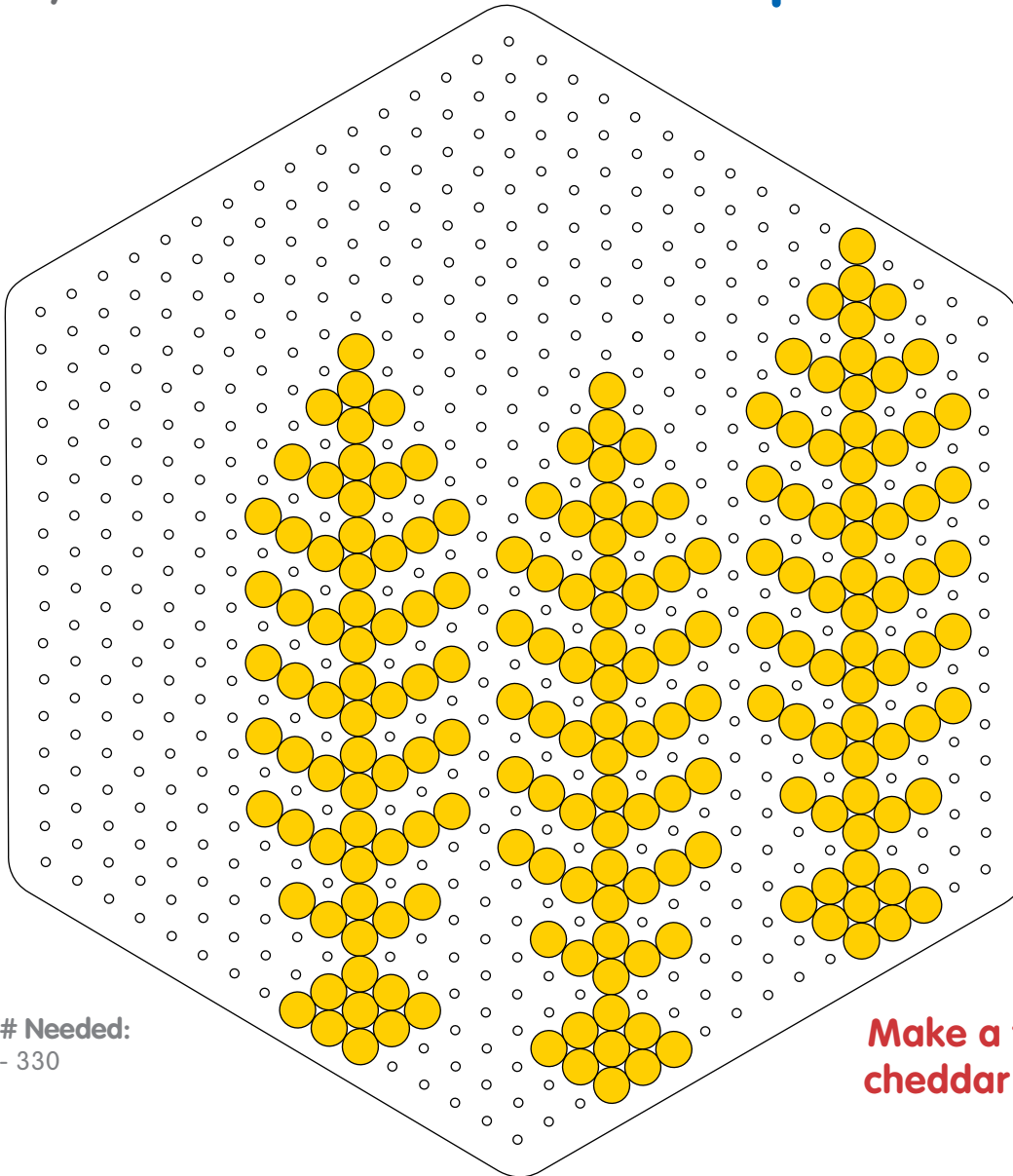
Make a total of 4 brown feathers.

Bead Color/# Needed:

● Brown - 384

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Warning: Parents - the ironing must be done by an adult only. Some irons may emit steam. Please keep children at a safe distance.



Bead Color/# Needed:

 Cheddar - 330

**Make a total of 5
cheddar feathers.**

ASSEMBLY

1 Lay your pumpkin on its side. The stem will be the turkey's tail. On your work surface, fan the cheddar and brown feathers as shown and glue together. Let dry. Then glue the feathers to the stem side of the pumpkin to form the tail.

2 Stack the wattle, head, and beak as shown and glue together, then glue to the pumpkin.

3 To create the legs, stack then glue the pieces red-orange-red-orange-red, and glue this assembly to the foot. Glue to the pumpkin.
