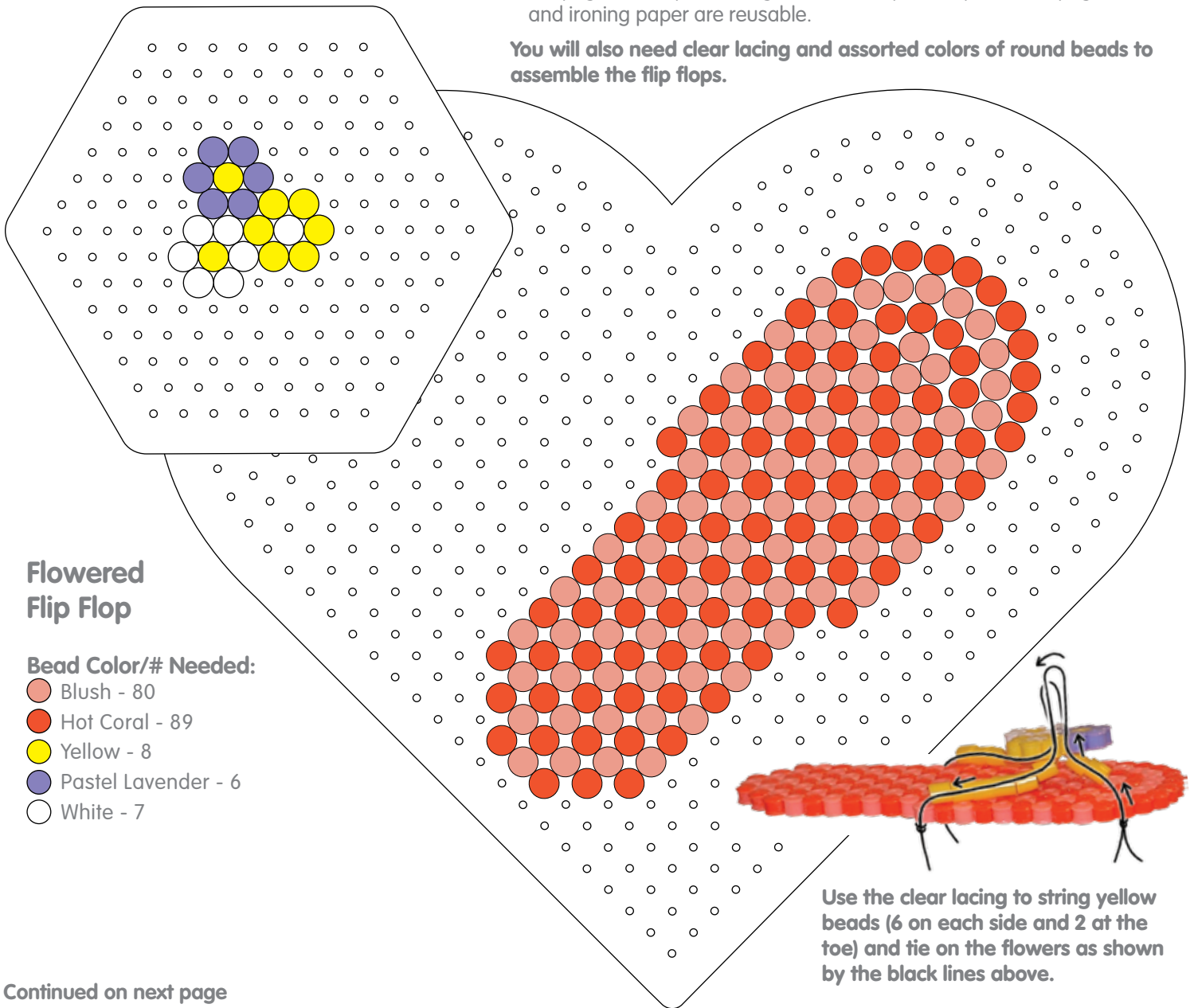




## Instructions






1. Use the large heart, small heart, and hexagon pegboards for your projects. If you're using a clear pegboard, slide the actual-size pattern underneath it. Place all the beads for the design. Bead counts are for one flip flop per design.
2. Cover the completed design with the ironing paper. Keeping the iron level, gently iron the beads in a circular motion for about 10 seconds to fuse the beads evenly. Ironed properly, the beads will still have an open center. On 3-D projects such as these, DO NOT OVER-IRON the beads as it will make the centers of the beads close and can make assembly difficult.
3. Once the design is cool, peel off the ironing paper. Lift your design from the pegboard; flip the design over and repeat step #2. Your pegboard and ironing paper are reusable.

You will also need clear lacing and assorted colors of round beads to assemble the flip flops.



## Flowered Flip Flop

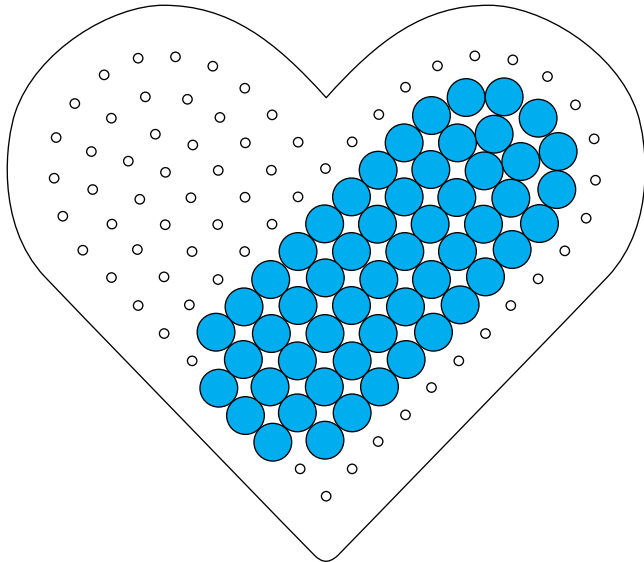
### Bead Color/# Needed:

-  Blush - 80
-  Hot Coral - 89
-  Yellow - 8
-  Pastel Lavender - 6
-  White - 7

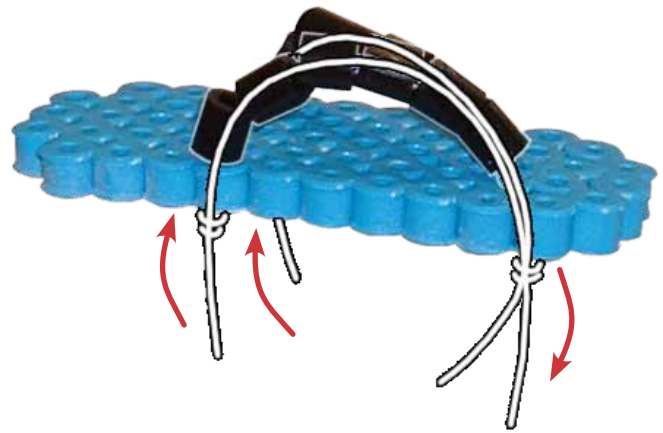
Use the clear lacing to string yellow beads (6 on each side and 2 at the toe) and tie on the flowers as shown by the black lines above.

## Turquoise Flip Flop



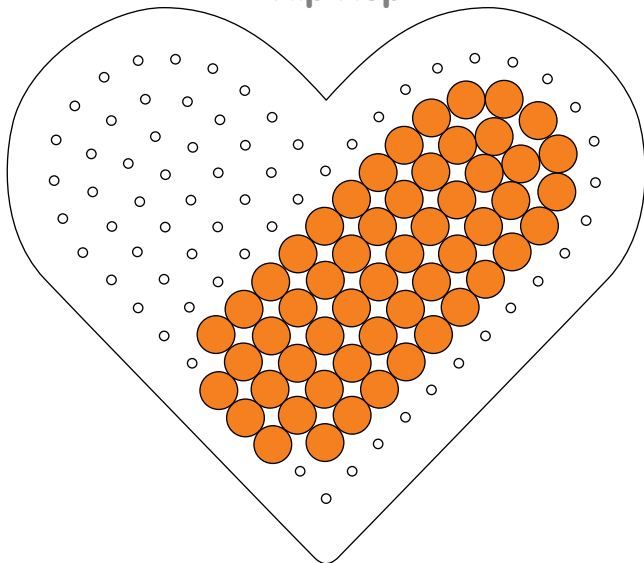
**Bead Color/# Needed:**  
● Turquoise - 55



Cut two pieces of lacing. Knot one end on each piece then insert the other end up through the flip flop (bottom to top) at the spots shown.

On each piece, string 5 black beads. Thread both pieces of lacing through 1 more black bead, then go down through the flip flop and knot the ends.

## Orange Flip Flop

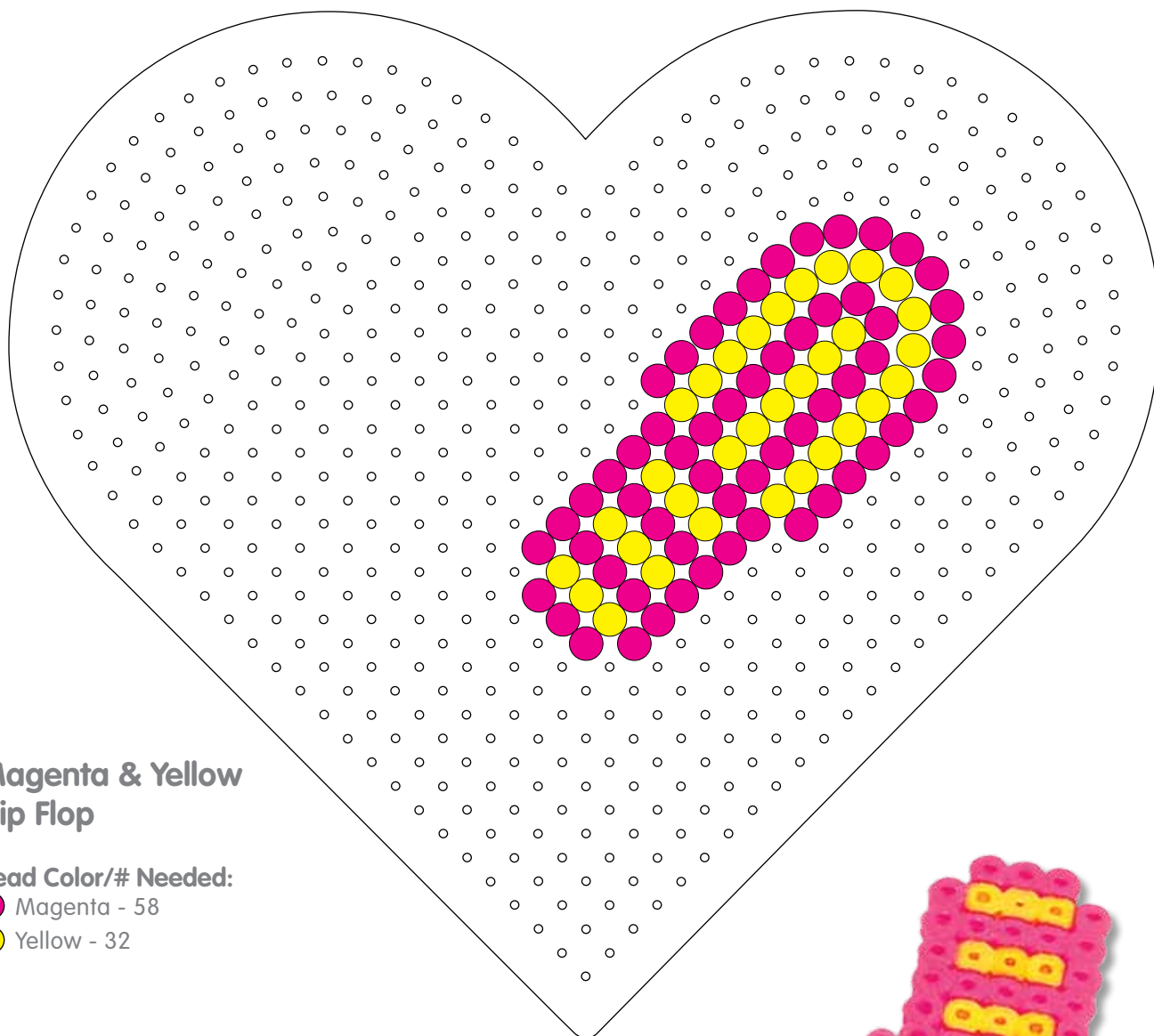


**Bead Color/# Needed:**  
● Orange - 55



String 21 round beads with the clear lacing in the same manner as the design above—10 on each side on one at the toe.

### Magenta & Yellow Flip Flop

**Bead Color/# Needed:**

- Magenta - 58
- Yellow - 32

Assemble this flip flop with clear lacing like the turquoise one on page 2, using 6 beads on each side (a mix of magenta and yellow) and 2 at the toe.
