Pegboards:

2 large squares

Scissors and clear tape

Iron and ironing paper

Two 8" x 14" pieces of sturdy cardboard

Masking tape (optional)

Hot glue gun

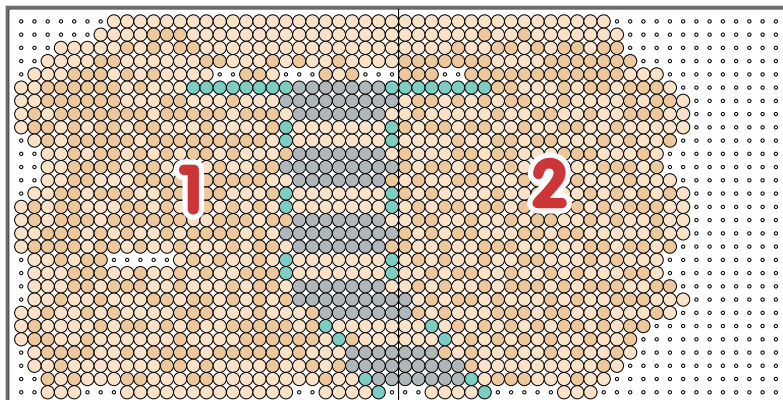

Instructions

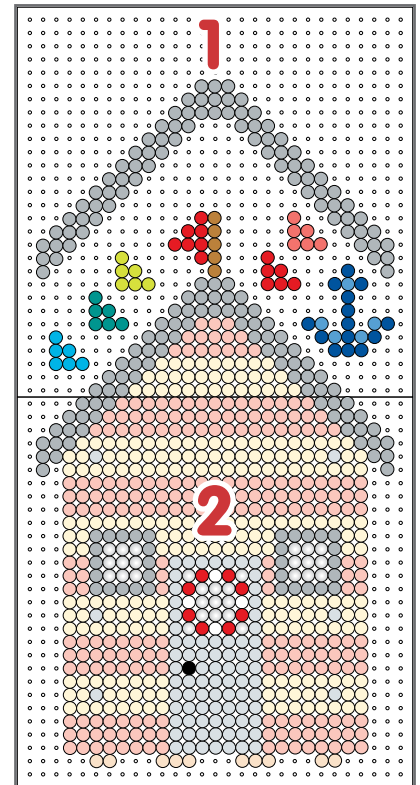
1. Assemble 2 large square pegboards as shown to create your project pieces, placing them on one of the large pieces of cardboard on a heat-safe surface that you can later use for fusing. Cut out and tape together the pattern sections. If you are using clear pegboards, slide the actual-size pattern underneath them. Place your beads following the pattern.
2. Ask an adult to fuse your designs—you can use our Standard Fusing Method explained here, or for large projects on multiple pegboards such as this, you might prefer to use the Tape Method for Fusing Large Projects. 3. **ASSEMBLY:** Glue the 2nd roof edge over the first. Glue the anchor in position as shown. To make the heart banner, glue the hearts to a piece of the string with small spaces between them. Tie the ends through the roof beads and secure on the back.

Insert the tabs at the bottom of the cottage into the slots behind the path on the base. Insert the surfboard in the last slot of the base. Place the chair on the right side of the base. If you feel it's needed, add a touch of hot glue during assembly (adults only, please).

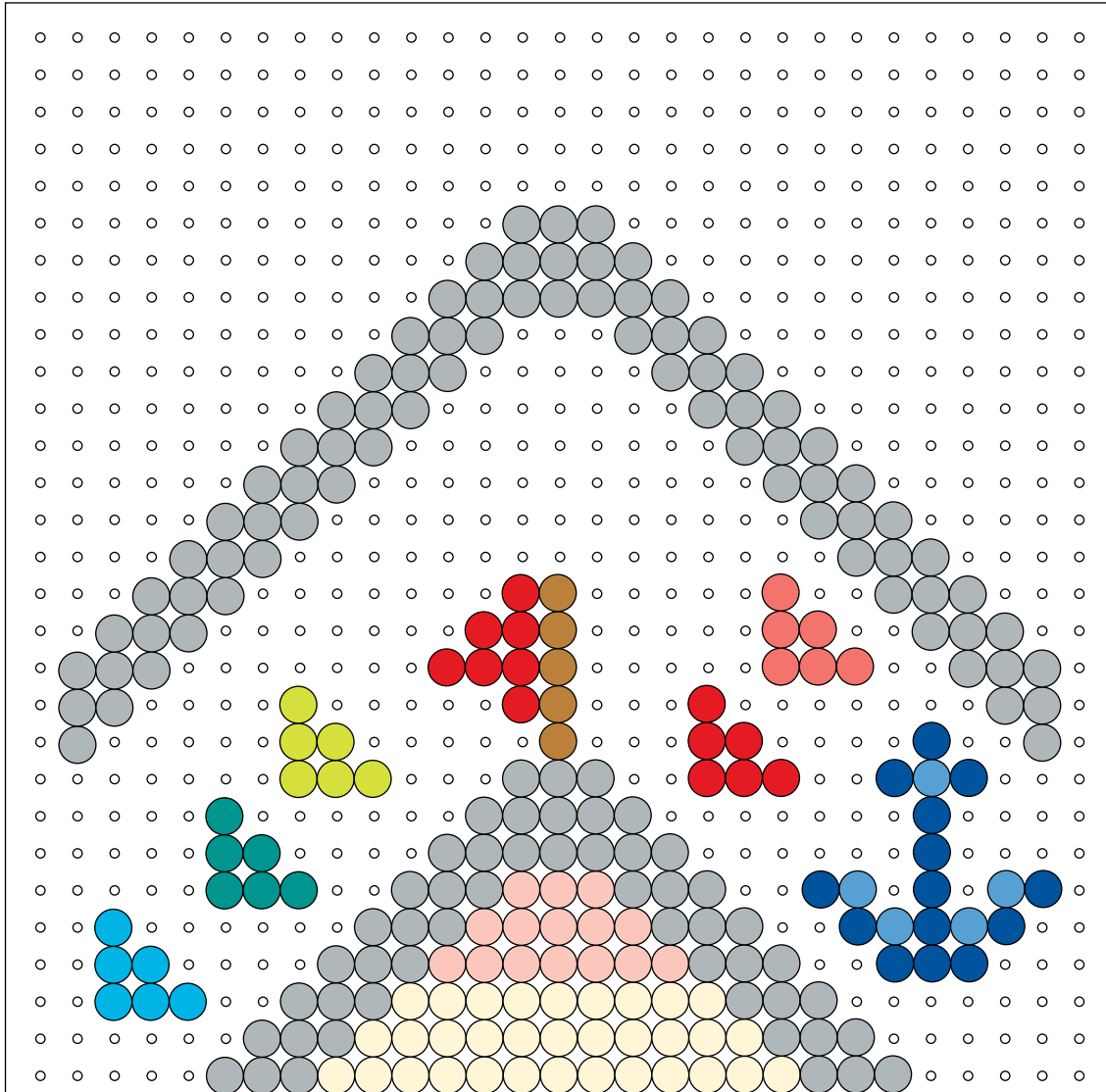

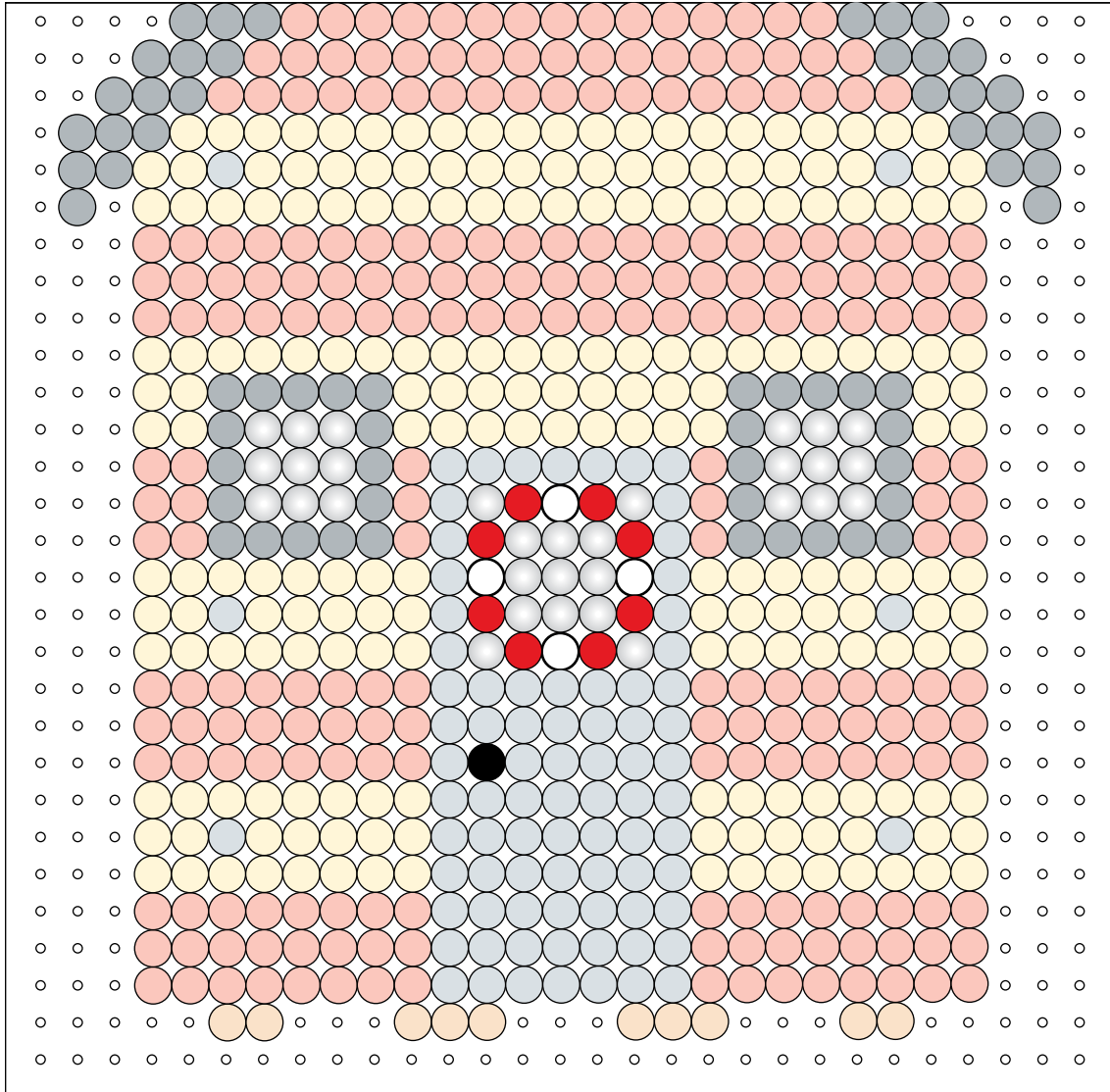

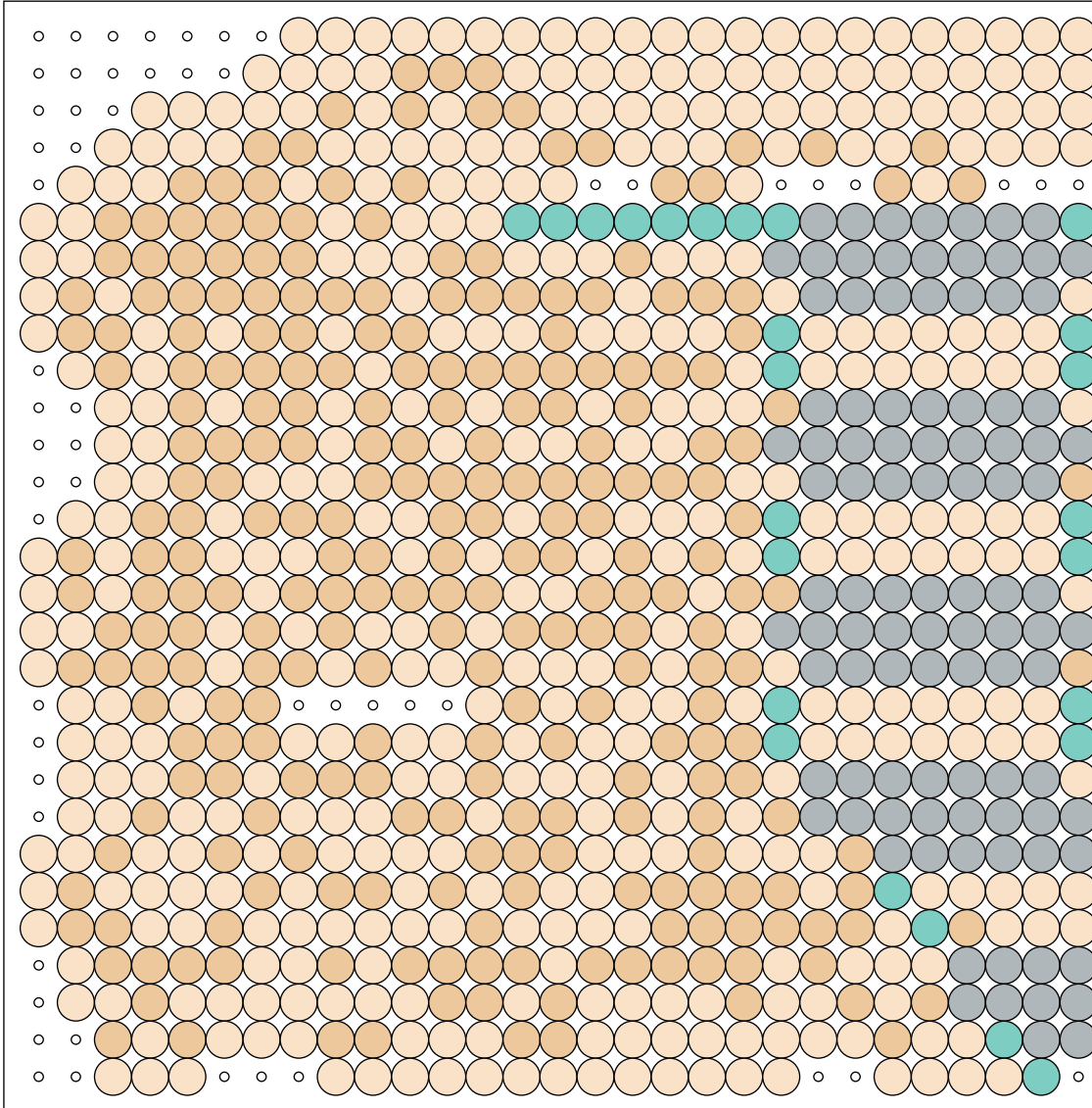
Cottage 1

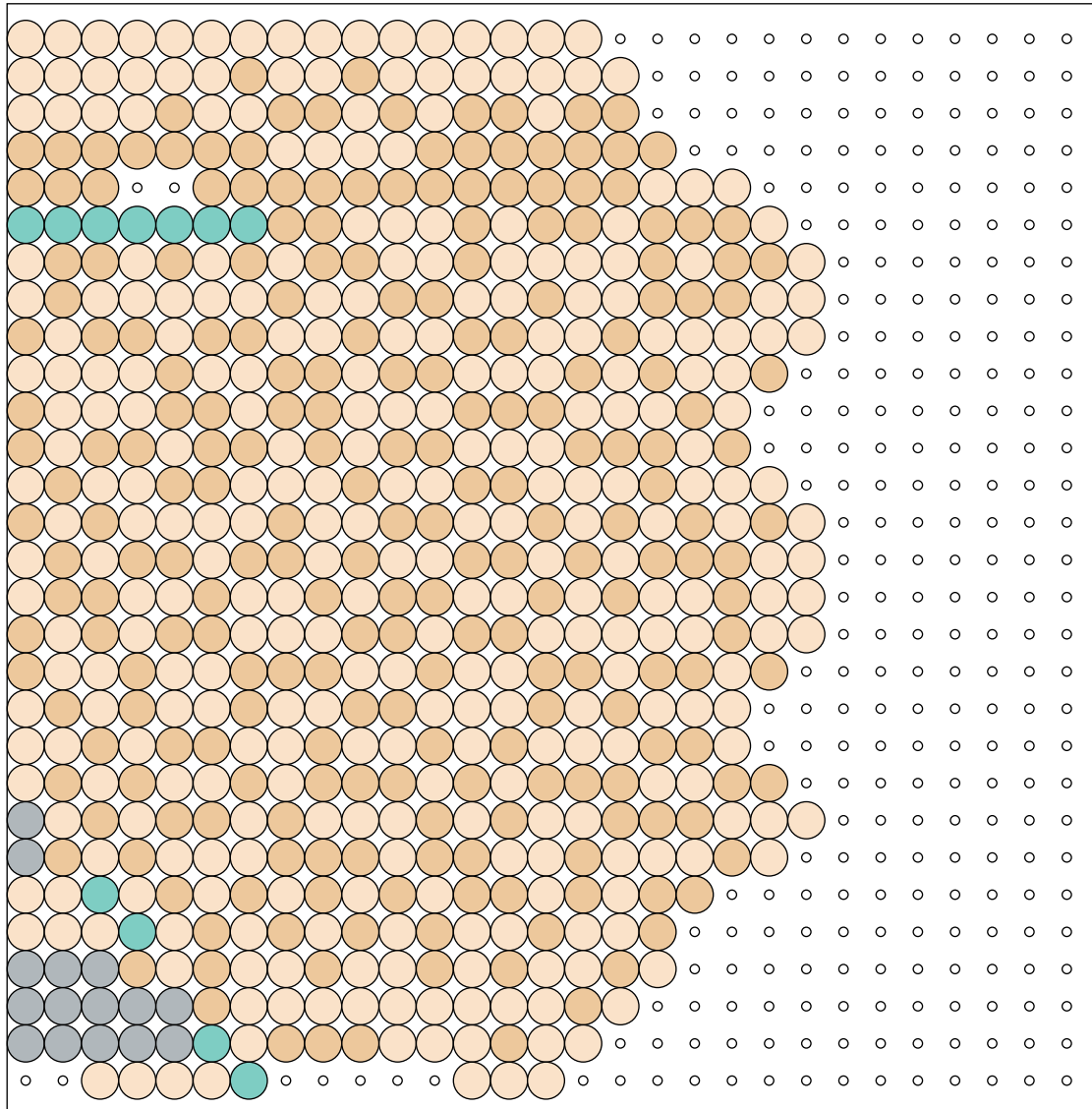

Fusing Instructions—**Only Adults Iron**



1. Place your pegboard on a flat, heat-safe surface.
2. Set a household iron to the medium setting. Place ironing paper over the pegboard. In a circular motion, begin to iron the project. Do not press down with the iron. As the beads begin to fuse, you will see circles of the beads start to show through the paper. When ironed properly, the beads will still have an open center. Let the design cool.
3. Remove the paper and bead design from the peg board. Flip the design over to expose the non-fused side. Repeat step two. Let cool completely. Your pegboard and ironing paper are reusable.

NOTE: Beads need heat for about 10-20 seconds per side to fuse evenly. Lift the paper occasionally to see how the beads are fusing. Depending on the size of the project, additional heating time may be required. **DO NOT OVER-IRON** the beads as it will make the centers of the beads close and can make the assembly you do with your project more challenging.
